Luke,

The ITE Trip Generation Manual does not have a "skate park" land use category. However, there is a "Public Park" category. The independent variable for a "Public Park" is acreage. The ITE Manuel indicates the Trip Generation Rate for a "Public Park" is 0.78 trips per acre. Geer Park has been its current size for many years. This project is not adding acreage to the park so there would be no increase in trips. (NOTE: The threshold for a TIA would be 1,000 new daily trips. The park would need to be around 1,300 acres.) The City does not pay SDCs to itself, so there would be no need to fill out a TGE.
