²The riparian corridor boundary is measured 50 feet horizontally from the top of bank on each side of a stream with the exception of the Willamette River, which measures 75 feet horizontally form the top of bank.

³This applies to trees and native vegetation in the riparian corridor (SRC 68.060 and SRC 68.020(p)).

⁴Required yard is a yard specified in the underlying zone for building and parking lot setbacks adjacent to streets, front, side and rear lot lines.

⁵Heritage Tree means a tree designated as a heritage tree pursuant to SRC 86.010.

⁶Significant tree means rare, threatened, or endangered trees of any size as defined or designated under State and Federal laws and included in the tree and vegetation technical manual and Oregon white oaks with a dbh of twenty-four inches or greater.
