Articles of Incorporation

OF

CAPITAL BAPTIST CHUNCH
We, B. L. Swinford, Orley Harmons, . J. Carey Moore, John L. Medford,
and W. J. Bishop, trustoes of the CAPITAL BAPTIST CHURCH, duly elected,
qualified, and acting as such,
whose names are hereunto subscribed, desiring to form a corporation under and by virtue of Chapter 462, Oregon Laws, 1941, providing for the creation of nonprofit corporations, do hereby associate ourselves together and make and execute in triplicate the following articles of incorporation, to wit:
ARTICLE I
The name assumed by this corporation and by which it shall be known is CAPITAL BAPTIST CHURCH
and its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

This corporation shall not engage in any form of trade or commerce, or carry on any activity which will result in a remunerative profit to the corporation or to its members. Subject to the foregoing limitations, the object, business, or pursuit of this corporation shall be as follows:

To promote the toachings of the Christian religion and to conduct a Baptist Church of New Testament order. The CAPITAL BAPTIST CHURCH shall maintain her historic position in rejecting alien immersion and open communion, and shall continue her vigorous support of the doctrines of: the Inspiration of the whole Bible, the Virgin Birth, the Doity, the Blood Atonement, the Bodily Resurrection, and the Second Coming of Jesus Christ our Lord; of world wide missions in cooperation with churches of like faith and order; of the immersion of believers only for baptism; and the upholding of the historic Paptist position in all other matters of doctrine and practice.

This corporation shall have the power to buy, sell, receive, acquire, hold, possess, manage, dispose of, and convey such real and personal property which it now has or may hereafter acquire for the use and benefit of the church or any institutions which the church may own, maintain, or operate; to have and exercise the power to mortgage, pledge, and hypothecate any or all of the real and personal property belonging to it as security for money berrowed or obligations which may be incurred in the purchase, maintenance, improvement, or in the conduct of its work; to receive and collect funds and cash, real and personal property, by will, contribution, domation, or otherwise, for the support and maintenance of the church and its work in general.

ARTICLE III

The estimated value of the property and money possessed by this corporation at the time of
executing these articles of incorporation isEight hundred fifty and no/100
(\$ 850.00),
and its revenue shall be derived from Voluntary contributions, tithes, and offerings.
ARTICLE IV
(1) The names and official titles, if any, and the postoffice addresses of the persons executing these articles are:

(2) The foregoing persons are to be the governing body which is to exercise the powers of the
corporation. (If this is not the case, state in the following space the true nature of the board of trustees
or directors, officers or other governing body which will exercise the powers of the corporation.)
The foregoing famed persons are the duly plotted trustees of approx
CHURCH, but are not the governing body of the corporation. The governing body of the said church and corporation is the controlation itself with every member having an equal voice or voting power when prosent at regular or called business meetings. All matters (except where the Oregon statutes provide otherwise) are decided by majority vote of the members present. The trustees, descens, and other officers of the church have only such powers as may be delegated to them by the church, and can act only in an advisory capacity otherwise. The said trustees, deacons, and other officers cannot sell, mortgage, or otherwise control the church property or program except as they are instructed by the church corporate body, or by this instrument.
(3) continued - The said trustees are to be elected in the following manner: one trustee to be first elected for the term of one (1) year; one trustee to be elected for the term of two (2) years; one trustee to be elected for the term of three (3) years; one trustee to be elected for the term of trustee to be elected for the term of four (4) years; and one trustee to be elected for the term of five (5) years, and thereafter the terms of all trustees shall be for five (5) years, with one (1) trustee to be elected each year.
In the event of a vacancy occurring in the office of trustee, during a term for which such trustee is elected, such vacancy shall be filled by vote of the membership of the church at a regular monthly business meeting following such vacancy.
(3) The successors to the corporators, or the board of trustees, or directors, officers or such
other governing body will be elected annually by majority voto of the members prosent
