Findings: Upon visual inspection tree has obvious signs of decay in the bottom 6 feet. A large cut from years ago, at ~6 feet from the ground, failed to heal over properly resulting in extensive decay. This has left the tree completely hollow as you can see in the attached photos.

Additionally, ~75% of canopy is missing due to damage sustained during recent storms.

Due to the extent of the rot and potential targets I consider this tree to be a hazard. My recommendation is to remove the tree before more of the canopy, or the entire tree, fails and lands on the house.
