I had a chance to look at both of these properties this morning.

Regarding 409 Idylwood. Both trees are in good condition and not declining. There is some deadwood and ice damage in the canopies, but pruning would be able to mitigate and have no impact on tree health. I can't speak to the potential structure damage but will note that the tree by the garage had its root system paved over when an asphalt "driveway" was installed to the back yard.

Regarding 2074 Turnage. The indicated douglas fir tree has obvious evidence of trunk rot. The tree is not dead, but has targets and a higher failure potential due to the rot.
