Dear Kiril Ivanov:

The Department received a request on December 17, 2021, from AKS Engineering & Forestry, LLC to add a minor area to the original delineation report's study area, which was previously approved on September 30, 2021. We have reviewed the revision request prepared by AKS Engineering & Forestry, LLC for the site referenced above. Based upon the information presented in the original report, and additional information submitted with this request, we concur with the waterway boundaries as mapped in revised Figure 5 and 5A. Please replace all copies of the preliminary wetland map with these final revised Department-approved maps.

Within the overall expanded study area, 2 waterways (Ditch 1 and Roadside Ditch) were identified. Again, no features within the original and now the expanded study area were determined to be jurisdictional. Therefore, neither is subject to the permit requirements of the state Removal-Fill Law. Because it is ephemeral, Ditch 1 is exempt per OAR 141-085-0510(49), and the Roadside Ditch is exempt per OAR 141-085-0515(10).

This concurrence is for purposes of the state Removal-Fill Law only. We recommend that you attach a copy of this concurrence letter to any subsequent state permit application to speed application review. Federal, other state agencies or local permit requirements may apply as well. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will determine jurisdiction under the Clean Water Act, which may require submittal of a complete Wetland Delineation Report.

This concurrence is based on information provided to the agency. The jurisdictional determination is valid for five years from the date of the original concurrence letter, September 30, 2021, unless new information necessitates a revision. Circumstances under which the Department may change a determination are found in OAR 141-090-0045 (available on our web site or upon request). In addition, laws enacted by the legislature and/or rules adopted by the Department may result in a change in jurisdiction; individuals and applicants are subject to the regulations that are in effect at the time of the removal-fill activity or complete permit application. The Department of State Lands has reviewed the wetland delineation report prepared by AKS Engineering & Forestry, LLC for the site referenced above. Based upon the information presented in the report, we concur with the waters boundaries as mapped in Figure 5 of the report. Within the study area, one water (Ditch) was identified. However, because the water was determined to be ephemeral, it is exempt per OAR 141-085-0515(3), and is not subject to state Removal-Fill permit requirements.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) received your request for an Approved Jurisdictional Determination (AJD) of the aquatic resources, including wetlands, within the review area on the property located at 4680 Hazelgreen Road NE, Salem, Marion County, Oregon at Latitude/Longitude: 45.000818°, -122.964935°. Other aquatic resources, including wetlands, that may occur on this property or on adjacent properties outside the review area are not the subject of this determination.

The Corps has determined there are no waters of the U.S. within the review area. The enclosed *Dry Land Approved Jurisdictional Determination Form* (Enclosure 1) provides the basis for our determination. A copy of the AJD Form can also be found on our website (https://www.nwp.usace.army.mil/Missions/Regulatory/Determinations/). The boundary of the review area subject to this AJD is identified on the enclosed drawings (Enclosure 2).

The delineation included herein has been conducted to identify the location and extent of the aquatic resource boundaries and/or the jurisdictional status of aquatic resources for purposes of the Clean Water Act for the particular site identified in this request. This delineation and/or jurisdictional determination may not be valid for the Wetland Conservation Provisions of the Food Security Act of 1985, as amended. If you or your tenant are U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) program participants, or

#### B. REQUIRED ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD. EXPLAIN RATIONALE FOR DETERMINATION THAT THE

**REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND:** An open water feature was delineated next to a culvert along the south portion of the review area. The feature formed on a compacted gravel area within loam soils and no discernable pattern of flow from the feature to the north or in any other cardinal direction. The open water feature has a restrictive gravel layer 2 inches below the soils in the bottom of the feature. A ditch feature was delineated extending from the open water feature north/northeast within the review area. The ditch feature exits the eastern boundary review area at the approximate eastern center of the review area. The ditch functions as a low flow swale, does not possess a streambed, streambanks, ordinary high water mark, and was not delineated as a wetland. The ditch was constructed from upland loam soils, only conveys

stormwater during rainfall events, and has no indication of carrying relatively permanent surface water flow. The roadside ditch along the north side of the property conveys stormwater during rainfall events and has no discernable ordinary high water mark. There is no evidence of sediment sorting and the soils are loam soils with high permeability. None of these features are jurisdictional waters of the U.S.
